Health Guarantee Agreement

The breeder guarantees that the puppy is in good health at the time of sale. The breeder assumes no responsibility for any injury or illness incurred after the puppy has been delivered to the purchaser. It is strongly recommended that the purchaser have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours of receipt. Should the examining veterinarian determine that the puppy is not in good health, a written statement must be provided to the breeder within that period. The puppy must be returned to the breeder immediately, in the same condition in which it was received. Upon confirmation of the veterinarian's findings, and provided the puppy has not sustained any damage or neglect, a full refund of the purchase price will be issued. The breeder is not liable for any veterinary expenses incurred by the purchaser.

The breeder has made every effort to ensure that the puppy has been raised in a healthy environment, with proper nutrition, socialization, exercise, and veterinary care. The puppy has received all age-appropriate vaccinations and deworming prior to the sale. While preventative measures have been taken, the breeder does not guarantee against the presence of intestinal parasites such as giardia or coccidia, as these are common in young puppies. Especially living on a small farm. Complete medical and vaccination records will be provided at the time of purchase.

The breeder does not guarantee the following: final adult weight, color, breeding ability, dental alignment (overbites/underbites), retained testicles, hernias, or patellar luxation. While breeding stock has been selected with the intention of minimizing the occurrence of these conditions, they are recognized as common and non-life-threatening.

The purchaser agrees to maintain the puppy's health through proper veterinary care, including annual wellness exams, vaccinations in accordance with current AVMA guidelines, routine dental care, monthly deworming, flea and tick prevention, and regular grooming.

No additional health guarantees are offered except in the case of a hereditary condition that significantly affects the puppy's quality of life or renders it unsuitable as a companion or breeding dog within three (3) years from the date of purchase. Such a condition must be confirmed in writing by a licensed veterinarian within seven (7) days of diagnosis. In such cases, the purchaser may choose between the following options:

1. Return of the dog for a full refund;
2. Return of the dog for a replacement puppy when available;
3. Retention of the dog with a 50% discount on a future puppy.
