Initial Health Guarantee

The breeder guarantees that the puppy is in good health at the time of sale. The breeder assumes no responsibility for any injury or illness incurred after the puppy has been delivered to the purchaser. It is strongly recommended that the purchaser have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours of receipt.

Should the examining veterinarian determine that the puppy is not in good health, a written statement must be provided to the breeder within that period. The puppy must be returned immediately in the same condition in which it was received. Upon confirmation of the veterinarian's findings, and provided the puppy has not sustained damage or neglect, the breeder will issue a full refund of the purchase price or provide a replacement puppy at the breeder's discretion. Veterinary expenses incurred by the purchaser are not covered.

Health & Preventative Care

The breeder has made every effort to ensure that the puppy has been raised in a healthy environment with proper nutrition, socialization, enrichment, exercise, and veterinary care. The puppy has received all age-appropriate vaccinations and deworming prior to sale.

While preventative measures have been taken, the breeder does not guarantee against common intestinal parasites, including giardia and coccidia, or temporary stress-related illnesses that may occur during a puppy's transition into a new home. Complete medical and vaccination records will be provided at the time of purchase.

Conditions Not Covered

The breeder does not guarantee final adult weight, color, dental alignment (overbites/underbites), retained testicles, hernias, patellar luxation, temperament, allergies, or injuries occurring after the puppy leaves the breeder's care.

Purchaser Responsibilities

The purchaser agrees to maintain the puppy's health through routine veterinary care, vaccinations, parasite prevention, dental care, regular grooming, proper nutrition, and prompt medical attention when necessary. Failure to provide reasonable care may void this health guarantee.

Five-Year Hereditary Health Guarantee

No additional health guarantees are offered except in the case of a hereditary condition that significantly affects the puppy's quality of life within five (5) years of the purchase date. The condition must be confirmed in writing by a licensed veterinarian and reported to the breeder within seven (7) days of diagnosis. The breeder reserves the right to obtain a second veterinary opinion before honoring any claim.

Available Remedies

If a covered hereditary condition is confirmed, the purchaser may choose:

- Return the dog for a full refund.
- Return the dog for a replacement puppy when available.
- Keep the dog and receive a 50% refund or 50% credit toward a future Crystal Rose Canines puppy.

The breeder's liability shall never exceed the original purchase price of the puppy.

Agreement

This document constitutes the entire Health Guarantee Agreement between the breeder and purchaser. No verbal statements shall alter or extend the terms of this agreement.
